Correct stimulus (or pressure) provided by correct environment = correct growth for health and dynamic equilibrium. Inappropriate environmental stimulus = incorrect growth and/or trauma. The recommendations below are guidelines to help you provide correct stimulus for the return or maintenance of health of your horse's feet, based on your horse's spectrum at the time of your appointment. Assess your horse daily as your horses health status may change! Failure to follow recommended guidelines could result in inappropriate stimulus and could cause harm to your horse's health and welfare.
